The Presiding Authority welcomed all councilors present for the meeting.

The Presiding Authority informed that the minutes of the Standing Committee dated 22/02/224 was not served as there was some corrections to be made as such it was not ready. Hence they are served today.

**Congratulatory Motion:**

**Item No 3:- Confirmation of the Minutes of the Standing Committee meeting of the Margao Municipal Council held on 23/01/2024 and 22/02/2024.**

Shri Francis Joanes said that he had suggested some correction in the minutes dated 22/02/2024. The same are not recorded in the minutes.

The presiding authority said that the corrections were to be done in the budget. The same has been corrected by the ACAO and ATO.

The minutes dated 23/1/2024, Resolution no 3633, Shri Ghanashyam Shirodkar said that it is mentioned that the draft chart will be prepared within a week's time. He asked whether this report is ready.

The Presiding Authority said that first the committee needs to be formed and also the survey to be conducted as to know how many trade licenses are being issued and how many traders are operating business without trade licence.

The Chief Officer said that all the A class Municipalities are charging different taxes. So first will form the committee and discuss the fees and then will prepare a chart and will be placed before the next Standing Committee meeting.

Smt Sushanta Kurtarkar said that if the fees are to be revised, we should also provide a time bound service to the public. There are lots of people facing problem while filling the online application for issuance of Trade Licence. She further requested that a single window counter may be set up where the trade licence can be provided within a specific time limit. It was seconded by Shri Camilo Barreto.

Resolution No.3642:- Shri Ghanashyam Shirodkar said that as per the decision of the Hon'ble High court the High Power Committee is constituted to resolve any issue related to Solid Waste. He further suggested that regarding installation of Gasifier may be decided by the High Power Committee.

The Chief Officer said that from the High Court the letter was sent to the office of Goa Pollution Board to repair the shed.

Shri Camilo Barreto said that he had visited the site at Pune along with the official, it was the duty of the official to conduct a meeting and to bring to the notice of the council about the working of this technologies.

The Minutes dated 22/02/2024, Resolution No 3645, Shri Sagun Naik Said that the council has approved for setting up the 10 TPD gasification Technology. He said whether this plant will work properly and solve the problem of the waste. He further said that atleast a presentation should be conducted and keep a perfect report to know about the functioning of this technology. Shri Sagun Naik said that without knowing the efficiency and practicality of the technology how we can opt for this technology, as the financial burden is to be borne by the Council.

Shri Deepak Dessai, Municipal Engineer said the GEDA only requires a resolution, subject to due approval from GSPCB. He said that when we visited the site at Pune we have seen 4 different types of Technologies out of which this Gasifier



Technology was found to be better. He further said that this Technology was installed at the society consisting of 3000 apts and we have seen this technology in the working condition at Pune.

Shri Francis Joanes said that the council has no objection to install this Gasifier plant. We only want to know the functioning of this plant.
